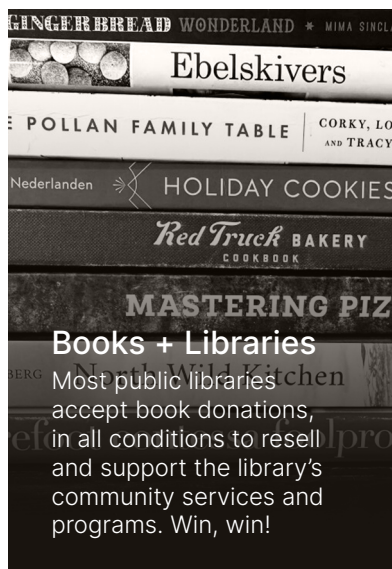
Academically Minded
